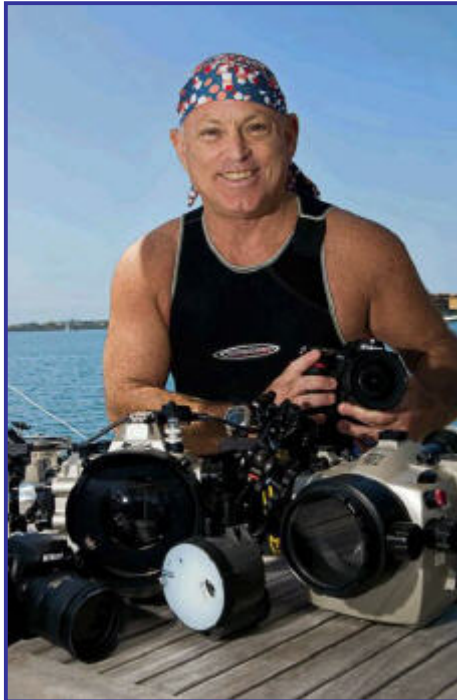

Including: 2005 Asian Diver Shootout held at Kungkungan Bay Resort and Tasik Ria, North Sulawesi; 2006 Layang Layang Digital Shootout, and 2007 Ocean Odyssey Shootout in Lembeh Strait.
